#### **Active Shooter Updates**

Officer James Sobota came to our HDSCLF meeting on March 14<sup>th</sup>. In an era when senseless killing seems to be far too common, the question is, "if you are the victim of an Active Shooter, will you know what to do?" First thing he said was that we are to RUN, HIDE, and FIGHT. For the RUN part, you need to have an escape route and plan in mind. Always leave your belongings behind as your life is more important. If possible, help other people to escape. Do not

move wounded people. For the HIDE part, hide in an area out of the shooter's view. Lock the door or block the entry to your hiding place. Then, silence your pager and cell phone and remain quiet. On the FIGHT part, fight as a last resort and only when your life is in imminent danger. When Law Enforcement arrives, remain calm and follow instructions by raising hands and spreading fingers. Officer Sobota talked about the shooting that happened in Florida. He stated that children were told to leave the building with their arms in the air. By following instructions, you are safe. Do not put your hands in your pockets while walking.


