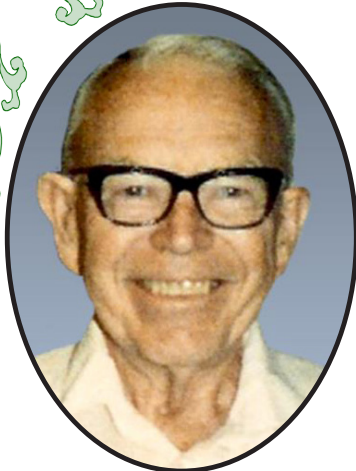
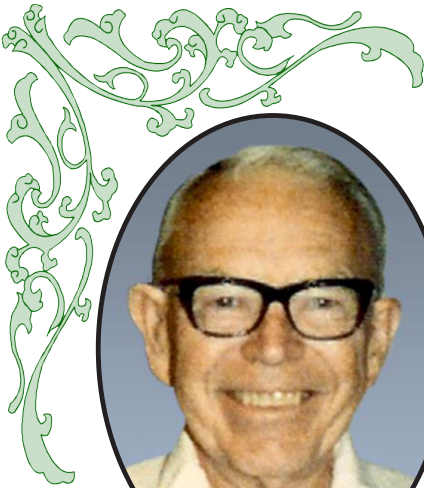

Editor's Message



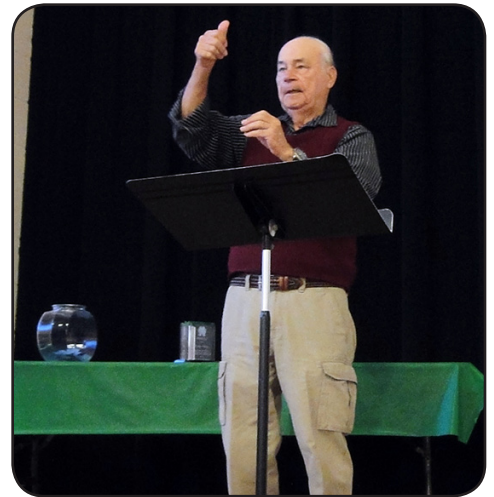
Hello Subscriber,

Registration Policy and Information

NOTE: Please read the following policy and information carefully.

PAYMENTS: You can register using a personal check, cashier's check, money order or credit card. Make checks payable to DSNC/DSA 2015 Asheville. After July 15, 2015, no personal checks will be accepted.

DO NOT SEND CASH BY MAIL.

CONFIRMATION: A confirmation letter with an ID number assigned to you will be emailed or mailed after payments are received. Please indicate your ID number in all correspondence with Registration Chairperson. Driver's license or personal identification card is required to be presented at the conference registration booth.

RETURNED (BOUNCED) CHECKS: Service fee for each returned check is \$25.00. Your registration will be processed after payment of the service fee.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS DUE TO ILLNESS AND DEATH: All combo and non-combo tickets are not refundable after July 15, 2015. There are two exceptions: illness and death. In case of illness after July 15, 2015, we will deduct 50% of your paid combo or non-combo ticket and \$20 DSA membership dues for 2015-2017. We require an appropriate medical documentation.

If you cancel before July 15, 2015 due to a registrant's illness, the regular cancellation policy, as shown on the registration form, will be used.

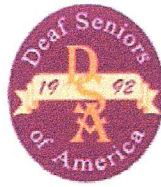
In the event of a registrant's death, we will refund full registration to the family after we receive a copy of death certificate or an obituary.

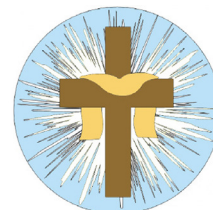

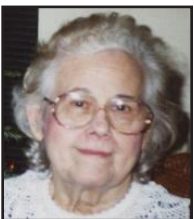
