spoke to the seniors about increased SCAMS on computers and iPhones. Several new ones are from Amazon

by scammers informing everyone that there are boxes of items to be picked up. But they want money upfront first! Please do not reply to them as they are not from Amazon. Other countries are sending these scams. Recently, text messages have been received threatening people to pay up or get arrested if they don't pay. Officer Sobota tells everyone not to handle these threats. He also explained that guns are legal to carry. The only time to use it on anyone is if they fear for their lives. Training is essential to know how to handle guns.



Then, Ricky Harris
(Deaf & Hard of Hearing Access Specialist) and his Assistant
Charis Mallory,

explained Tax Time. He encouraged everyone to call the Mayor's Office to have an Interpreter set up. However, they will set up with H R Block to help everyone with their taxes. They both emphasized contacting them if anyone has a problem with getting an Interpreter because they can contact the person to let them know more about the ADA Law. If Interpreter is not available, anyone can request Cart Caption. Google has set up a "Live Transcribe" system for the deaf to read messages announced anywhere on airplanes, meetings, etc. It is not available on Apple iPhones yet. Ricky Harris also said that Banks doesn't like to use Sorenson as that is a 3rd party involved. He has had to communicate with the Bank's staff about handling those calls from deaf people.
